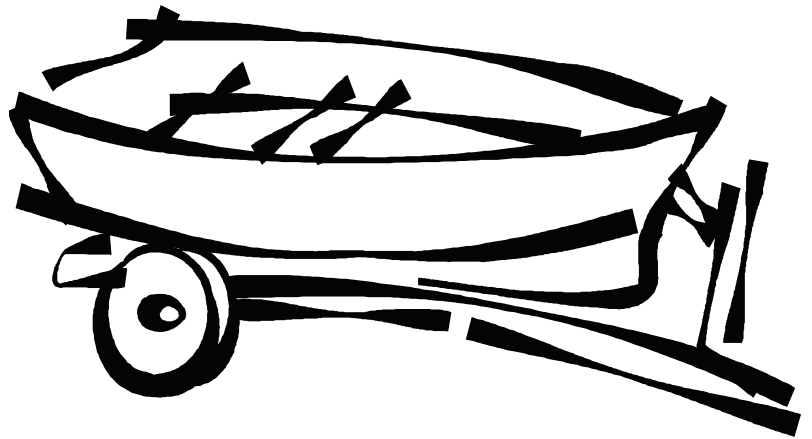


"What Floats Your Boat"

Join Karl Weinert, master boat builder, and his wife Debi, who own and operate The Tennessee Boatbuilding School located in Big Sandy, Tennessee for a weekend of learning what goes into authentic, hands-on boat building Saturday and Sunday January 27-28th



Karl has 25 years as a professional boatwright to his credit. Karl and Debi started the school in 2004. The class allows student to finish the course in one or two days. During the one-day session, the student builds a 15-foot long canoe called a pirogue. The students in the two-day school build a 12-foot long rowboat called a Bevins skiff. The best part is the students get to keep their boat!

The Weinerts will be displaying some of their boats and discussing the craftsmanship that goes into a well-hewn wooden hull.

Debi will be serving grog (cider) and sea biscuits to customers. Also joining them will be local Tennessee Boat Builders displaying their own handcrafted boats during the weekend.
